When you wage war against a nameless, stateless, formless enemy – an enemy with goals as uncertain as its methods – it's hard to see how war can ever end. – Rosa Brooks

The result: a greater tolerance for secrecy and coercion, the inevitable expansion of the military, and a society distrustful of the entity tasked with protecting it.


